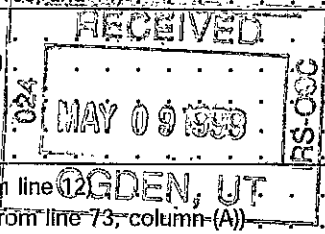

1997 was the first year of operation of the organisation and hence there was very limited fundraising by way of direct and indirect public support. As a result, the 2% of total amount collected through fundraising is a very insignificant number. This is leading to the public support percentage as being computed as 0.

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
